Welcome

Head Coaches Linda Daniels and I welcome you to the 2009 – 2010 Kegler's Pub & Pin USBC Youth Bowling season! We have a fun-filled season planned for the area's young bowlers!

New Bowling Schedule at Kegler's

Thanks to some great feedback from the bowlers and their parents last year, Kegler's Pub & Pin is now offering three, 10-week bowling sessions for all current and new bowlers. Your child(ren) will have the option of bowling in 1, 2 or all 3 "sessions" during the school year.

A 3-session bowling season, instead of one long season, is very common around the country. It gives young bowlers the flexibility to be involved in other activities if they like. A 3-session bowling option also allows for more new bowlers to join a Youth league, when perhaps they couldn't have done so in the past due to other commitments. Our goal at Kegler's is to make bowling an easy choice for everyone!

How does the 3-Session Program work?

First, you simply need to choose your sessions. You are invited to enroll your child(ren) in 1, 2 or 3 sessions, which are scheduled as follows:

- **Fall Session** (Sept – Nov)
- **Winter Session** (Dec – Feb)
- **Spring Session** (Mar – May)

We encourage you to enroll your child(ren) in at least 2 sessions to provide enough practice and competition opportunities for continued growth in bowling each year.

Attached is the bowling schedule for the Thursday Youth League (3:45 PM) and the Saturday Youth League (9:00 AM). Please note: *This is a combined calendar – each league bowls only once a week.*

Fees

The fee for each pre-paid 10-week season is \$80 per bowler (paid directly to the League, not to the center). This price includes all lineage costs such as shoes, balls, and lanes as well as year-end trophies and free USBC-certified coaching. If you have more than one child bowling at a time, payment arrangements can be made. Please see Andrew or Linda for details.

Annual sanctioning dues are \$17 per bowler, which covers **all three 10-week sessions**. Your child's Official United States Bowling Congress (USBC) dues include:

- Cool-Max™ bowling jersey (**free**)

- Subscription to *US Youth Bowler* magazine (**free**)
- A USBC-recognized bowling average (required for tournament and state competition)
- Eligibility for the USBC Youth Bowling Awards Program
- League Award Emblems (brand new designs this year)
- Membership in America's largest, most popular, sanctioned competitive sport

If your child will bowl in only one 10-week session, you may enroll him or her in a Basic USBC Membership for just \$5. Neither the jersey nor the magazine subscription is included.

How do we sign up?

One of our goals here at Kegler's Pub & Pin is to ensure that enrolling your child in the bowling program is as easy and as convenient for you as possible. If you can't attend Registration Day on Wednesday, December 2 or Wednesday, December 9 (option 1 below), you are encouraged to enroll your child over the phone or by snail mail.

By Wednesday, December 2 or December 9, 2009, please enroll your child(ren) in 1 or 2 of the remaining ten-week bowling sessions using either of the following methods:

1. Attend Registration Day on either **Wednesday, December 2 or Wednesday, December 9 from 3:30 AM to 5:30 PM**, at Kegler's Pub & Pin on Hwy 63 in Spooner; free parking on Oak Street
2. Call **715-635-8706** to pay-by-phone with your credit card
3. Mail your completed Sign-Up Form & a check, **made payable to Thursday (or Saturday) Youth League**; send it "Attention: Linda Daniels" to Kegler's Pub & Pin (use address on Page 1)

Please note: Cash, Checks, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover accepted.

In all cases, each bowler will need to complete a USBC enrollment card on or before the first day of bowling so that your child's free bowling jersey and magazine subscription can be ordered and shipped.

Who will coach my child?

All coaches at Kegler's have passed a stringent background check. Ms. Linda Daniels of Spooner and I coach on Saturdays. Mr. Jerry Mortensen of Shell Lake joins us on Thursdays.

We are working to recruit one to two more coaches this season, so if you are interested, please let us know by calling 715-635-8706. You don't have to be a high-average bowler to be a coach—only a love of bowling is required!

Congratulations—you have chosen America's # 1 participation sport. Remember, bowling is a lifetime sport where all children participate regardless of ability, no one rides the bench, *and everyone has fun*.

The Sign-Up Form is attached. Please complete and return it to Kegler's Pub & Pin **by either December 2 (for Thursday bowlers) or December 9 (for Saturday bowlers)**. Late registrations are welcome on a first come, first served basis. Welcome to Kegler's, everyone!
